\*\* The preparation of an Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) is the project goal. These are prerequisites for the issuance of federal permits relating to the events, most notably including the Special Event Permit proposed to be issued by the National Park Service, the Marine Event Permit proposed to be issued by the U.S. Coast Guard, and permits from the Army Corps of Engineers relating to in-water construction activities.
