

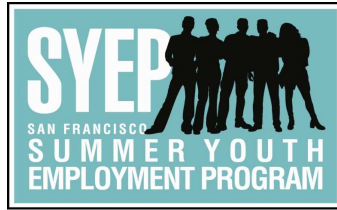

SYEP General Info

- **Total Funding:** Approximately \$1 Million
- **Program Dates:** June 29th – August 28th (6 weeks for in school youth & 8 weeks for out of school youth)
- **Service Level:** 455 Youth (Ages: 16- 24 years old)
- **Apps submitted:** 790 (mostly 18-24 years old)
- **Service Model:** Youth work approx 20 hours a week

Combination of work experience, job-readiness training and educational enhancement services

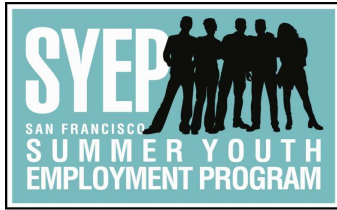
- **Expected Outcomes:** Youth will obtain work readiness skills, educational enhancement and develop a transition plan

SYEP Timeline

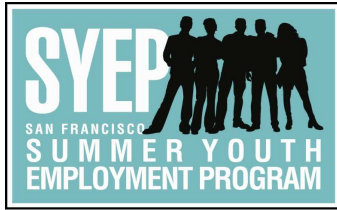
- April 17 RFP Let
 - May 8 Proposals due (12 Proposals Received, 6 selected)
 - May 29 Award Notification
 - June 1 – June 19 Application Acceptance and initial WIA Certification
 - June 15 – July 17 Selection Process and HSA Review
1. WIA Eligible 2. Priority Population 3. # of barriers/date applied 4. Provider Recommendation
- June 29 – July 2 First wave of Pre-JRT (225 priority pop youth)
 - July 6 – July 10 Second wave of Pre-JRT (100 youth)
 - July 10-19 Notifications to non-eligible Youth
 - July 20 – 31 Final wave of Pre-JRT (100 youth)
 - August TBD Educational Resource Fair
 - Sep 1 – Sep 30 Transition plan – Exit/Transition to year round services
