The San Francisco Substandard Income for WIA Eligibility has been revised effective July 5, 2011.

- /a. The State of California, Employment Development Department issues Directive Number: WSD11-2, 2011 70 Percent LLSIL and Poverty Guidelines. The "San Francisco Substandard Income Criteria" reflect, for each size of family, the larger of two federally specified income criteria. These two criteria are the "Official (Nationwide Urban) Poverty Level" computed, revised, and published annually by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in the Federal Register on January 20, 2011 and the 2011 seventy percent of the "Lower Living Standard Income Level" (LLSIL) for the San Francisco Metropolitan Statistical Area computed, revised, and published by the Secretary of Labor in the Federal Register on March 21, 2011.
- /b. Maximum income amount for each size of family for the period (6 months) immediately preceding the date of application which is applicable for purposes of determining eligibility for WIA Title I programs.
- /c. Add \$2,838 for each additional family member.
